SUMMER PLAYGROUND

During Session II of Playground, children in grades K-4 may remain for a counselor-supervised lunch (you provide), followed by a summer Tae Kwon Do program. Besides having fun, children will spend time discussing respect, cooperation and focus, along with learning techniques of self defense, blocks and kicks.
