Minutes of the Village of Fayetteville Board of Trustees meeting held Tuesday, October 10, 2017 at 6:00pm.

Mayor Olson called the meeting to order at 6:00pm in the Board Room of the Fayetteville Village Hall.

Mayor Olson led those present in a recitation of the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES OCTOBER 10, 2017

Trustee Small made a motion to accept the minutes of the October 10, 2017 meeting. Trustee Randall seconded the motion and it was carried by a unanimous vote.

ABSTRACT #8

Trustee Kinsella made a motion to approve Abstract #8 in the amount of \$135,762.71. Trustee Small seconded the motion and it was carried by unanimous vote.

CHAPTER 187- SHEDS

Code Enforcement Officer, Mike Jones, outlined and recommended changes to Chapter 187 Section 75, entitled Sheds. Mr. Jones noted that there are some discrepancies within this section of the code that he would like to clean up.

Trustee Kinsella made a motion to hold a Public Hearing on November 13, 2017 on or around 6:00pm to hear comment on the proposed amendments to Chapter 187-75 of the Village of Fayetteville Code, entitled Sheds. Trustee Randall seconded the motion and it was carried by unanimous vote.

FITCH STREET/DRY CLEANERS

CEO, Mike Jones, informed the board that he met with Susan Poissant, to discuss the properties on the corner of East Genesee Street and Highbridge Street that is owned by Guy Hart Jr. Ms. Poissant informed Mr. Jones that they are currently working with Dunn & Sgromo Engineering concerning the Floodway.

Mayor Olson made a motion to authorize Mike Jones, CEO, to start Chapter 55 proceedings on the former Car Wash, Fayetteville Dry Cleaners and Dr. Sherwood Properties, all currently

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owned by Guy Hart Jr. Trustee Kinsella seconded the motion and it was carried by unanimous vote.

FIRE DEPARTMENT FULL-TIME AND PART TIME HIRES

Trustee Kinsella made a motion to promote Timothy Chrysler from Part-Time Status to Full – Time Status effective October 29, 2017 at a beginning salary commensurate with a current Full-Time Firefighter/Paramedic at the 4 year rate. Trustee Small seconded the motion and it was carried by unanimous vote.

Trustee Kinsella made a motion to hire Jeremy Carnahan, as a Part-Time Firefighter/Paramedic, at a rate of \$19.00 per hour. Trustee Small seconded the motion and it was carried by unanimous vote.

Mayor Olson attended the ceremony held to swear in the new Town of Manlius Police Chief, Michael Crowell.

Codes Officer Jones informed the board that he will be attending a seminar at Onondaga Community College regarding abandoned properties.
