VILLAGE OF FAYETTEVILLE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION RIBBON CUTTING

WHAT: Join us as we unveil the first electric vehicle charging station installed by the Village of Fayetteville, which will provide free services for residents and visitors. The station was recently installed at the public parking lot at the corner of Brooklea Drive and Elm Street, which is in close proximity to shops, restaurants, bars and the Town offices in the lower village. Electric vehicle charging stations support Governor Andrew M. Cuomo's aggressive goal to reduce greenhouse gas emissions 40 percent by 2030 by encouraging the growth of electric vehicle use. The station is also an important first step towards meeting the goals of the Village's Climate Action Plan, adopted in December 2014, which called for installing 10 stations and converting 5% of the community's vehicles to electric by 2030.
