- + Summary of comments:
 - o Vision Statement:
 - Add back to the Vision Statement – “Preserving the integrity of our historic character.”
 - o Land Use and Development
 - Add back in preservation of historically significant buildings
 - Should this address accessory dwelling units?
 - o Natural and Cultural Resources
 - Former #4 – add this back to support programs, special events, and activities that promote the Village’s historic and natural resources.
 - Add an invasive species statement in the strategies for climate change, adaptation, and sustainability
 - Bury power lines – add to the climate change section – making infrastructure more resilient
