CURBSIDE / DEBRIS PICKUP POLICY

The following will be collected at the curbside by the Village of Fayetteville Department of Public Works only where no Building Permit is required and the owner/resident and/or unpaid volunteers participate in the removal, making repairs, modifications, or additions to the entire project.

Garbage, Recycling & Metal Pickup Routes: Any questions with pickup call the DPW 315-637-6065

Tuesday: The Northside of E. Genesee St. area and Highbridge St. to Mott Rd. area.

Wednesday: The Eastern section of the Village. Includes both sides of E. Genesee St. to Salt Springs St. going east.

Thursday: The Southside of E. Genesee St., W. Genesee St. and N. Burdick St.

- a. Garbage containers should be of reasonable size (**No 90 lb. containers**) weight should be limited to 55lbs. Garbage should not be loose and should be bagged and tied then put into a container in good condition.
- b. Items that can be put out with your garbage are; Metal, Carpets, Rugs, Padding, Mattresses and Upholstered Furniture.
- c. Metal items will be picked up after garbage and recycling is done.
- d. Larger items will be picked up after garbage and recycling is done
- e. Recycling should be put into blue bins and not mixed in the garbage. Cardboard that will not fit into blue bins should be cut into a reasonable size and tie up.
Blue Bins replacements are available at the DPW garage or by calling 315-637-6065.

THE DPW WILL NOT PICK UP: Asbestos in any form, Roofing Materials, Liquid Paint, Paint Thinner, Solvents, Automotive Batteries, Acids, Alkalis, Drain Cleaners, Oils, Fuels, Propane or Fuel Tanks, Televisions or Electronics of any kind. There may be other items included so for any questions regarding the disposal of these or other hazardous items, Call Onondaga Resource Recovery Agency at 315-453-2866 or visit www.ocrra.org

All Building Debris, Yard Waste and Hard Fill must be kept separated for pickup.

Yard Waste:

Pickup starts on **Monday** and continues until all Village streets have been picked up. The DPW may suspend Yard Waste pickup during the Fall (leaf season) and Winter.

- a. Brush
- b. Tree branches
- c. Leaves (picked up during regular season as above; during leaf season, October to December large amounts of leaves will be picked up on a different schedule)
- d. During leaf season pickup, please rake them to the curb but not in the street (especially near storm drains). If you want to bag your leaves, use biodegradable bags only NO plastic. Leaves are picked up daily on a continuous rotating basis until the end of the season.
- e. Must be generated at and removed from the property where the debris is placed for curbside pick-up

Yard Waste does not include:

- a. Grass clippings (only collected during leaf season if mulched in with leaves)
- b. Lumber or large trees
- c. Lawn edgings, *see Hard Fill

Hard Fill

Pickup is on the **Third Friday** of the month. If a Holiday occurs the third Friday of the month, pickup will be the following Monday.

- a. Dirt
- b. Stones
- c. Lawn edgings
- d. Bricks
- e. Concrete (broken up slabs, blocks, deck footers/fence posts)
All wood must be removed.

Building Debris:

Pickup is the **Last Friday** of the month. If a Holiday occurs the last Friday of the month, pickup will be the following Monday.

- a. Must consist of non-hazardous material, including but not limited to asbestos
- b. Shall not contain loose nails. Lumber shall be nail free or bent over to protect employees
- c. All loose debris must be placed within a container that meets the Village's criteria for Garbage Containers.
- d. Shall be secured so that it will not be spread by wind or animals
- e. Any debris that will deteriorate, break down or become heavy with absorbed moisture must be placed in a water-resistant container or wrapped in a water-resistant covering to keep the material dry. This includes, but is not limited to plaster lath, sheetrock, insulation, and paper fabrics.
- f. Must be generated at and removed from the property where the debris is placed for curbside pick-up and where no permit was required.

No debris shall be placed outside for pick-up more than twenty-four (24) hours before the scheduled pick-up.

Any remaining containers or debris that was not picked up must be removed from the curb-side within twenty-four (24) hours after the scheduled pick-up.

The Village of Fayetteville Department of Public Works will not pick-up any debris, yard waste or hard fill that is generated when a Building Permit has been issued or when the debris and yard waste is produced by paid persons/businesses, to include but not limited to, contractors, landscapers, or tree removal services.

With prior consent, considerations will be given to residents with limited abilities.

The DPW will mark this hanger or a OOPS sticker if something is wrong with the items that have been put out for pickup.

OOPS!!

- ___ Container is over weight - 55 lbs. or less
- ___ Container is to large
- ___ Item is too large for pickup
- ___ Hazardous Materials
- ___ Paint in cans not dried out
- ___ No electronics; (Some examples, TVs, Computers, Monitors, Printers, Blue rays, Radios)
- ___ Hard Fill out on wrong date – 3rd Friday of the month (unless a holiday)
- ___ Construction Debris out on wrong date – Last Friday of the month (unless a holiday)
- ___ No grass clippings - Only during leaf season October to December and mixed with leaves
- ___ Different materials not separated for pickup
- ___ Other: _____
