RE: OCRRA Operations Update

While the Governor's executive orders to limit staffing and ensure essential services continue, the County Executive's lifting of the shelter-in-place program means OCRRA's operations are evolving.

Amboy Compost Site

Is now accepting **drop off of materials only** from commercial and municipal customers with an account starting Monday, April 27, 2020.

- Normal hours resume on April 27: Monday – Friday, 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.
- Starting May 4, 2020, hours expand to Monday – Saturday, 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.

We are able to facilitate municipal yard waste drop off without person-to-person contact due to the automated scale system at Amboy. If you have not used the scale system before, prior to drop off **contact Kevin Spillane at (315) 694-8009**.

- Haulers, whether municipal or private haulers on behalf of a municipality, should enter the site through the main gate. Please shut the gate behind you as the site is still closed to residential traffic.
- Tarp your loads.
- Maintain 6' of social distance and wear a mask to protect yourself and our staff.

The Amboy Compost Site will open to **all** customers and begin selling material Monday, May 4, 2020, with social distancing and masks for all drivers and customers.

Jamesville Compost Site

Is now accepting **drop off of materials only** by commercial and municipal customers with an account starting Monday, April 27, 2020.

- Normal hours resume on April 27, 2020: Monday – Friday, 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.
- Starting May 4, 2020, the hours expand to Monday – Saturday, 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.

Jamesville does not have a scale system, so all transactions require person-to-person contact. If you are a municipality or hauler in need of drop off capabilities, but do not have an account – or unsure if you have an account, contact Kevin Spillane at (315) 694-8009 to make arrangements.

The Jamesville Compost Site will begin selling materials to all commercial and municipal customers (those without accounts) starting Monday, May 4, 2020. Hours: Monday – Saturday, 7:30 am – 3:30 pm.

Residential services will begin on Thursday, May 7, 2020. The site will be open to residents Thursday – Saturday only; haulers and municipalities will continue to use a Monday – Saturday schedule. All visitors are required to wear a mask and tarp their loads.

Ley Creek Transfer Station

Is open Monday–Friday. It remains closed on Saturdays. All visitors are required to wear a mask and tarp their loads.

Recycling Collection

Please instruct your team / hauler to leave blue bins that are full of yard waste at the curb. Do not collect them. Picking up this material only leads to the contamination of good recyclables.

Ongoing Communications
