

I also would like to update you on some projects that are happening in the village over the next few months. Please check out our website for more information on all that is happening in the village.

- Fayetteville Senior Center Renovation project will be completed early April, look for grand opening and opening house details on the website
- Limestone re-stripping will start in early spring, look for this exciting project when you're in Limestone plaza
- Limestone & Bishops Brook Rehab project will start in May and finish before summer's end
- American Rescue Plan allocation will be decided with help and input from all stakeholders, county, town, federal governments
- Annual budget hold tax rate at current level, working with departments on the plan as this newsletter is written
- Paving this summer will finish Brookside streets that we didn't finish last year (pending state funding)
- Parks upgrades at Coulter, Washington and Dog Park at Duguid Reservoir
- Planning phases for all special events in village- Memorial Day Parade, Fayetteville Festival, Christmas Tree Lighting Ceremony

Lastly, I want to thank all the village residents for their well wishes when my family came down with COVID. I cannot thank you all enough for the cards, emails, food and well wishes for my family and me. I really can't express how much it meant to our family. 




