Greetings all,

Winter has been kind to us so far, although rest assured the DPW is prepared for whatever weather is yet to come our way! There is much coming up in the Village as you will see in this newsletter. The Annual Turkey Dinner at the Fayetteville Senior Center will be held on March 3rd. This has been a fund-raising dinner instituted by Mayor McIntosh and continued throughout Mayor Olson's tenure. As Deputy Mayor I'm pleased to continue the tradition of this dinner. All items for the dinner are donated and all funds collected go to the Senior Center. I hope you will support this long-standing tradition and enjoy a turkey dinner!

You received a card about collection of Bulk Items, Construction Debris and Hardfill. These items are picked up once a month and you are requested to schedule with the Village (online or by calling the Village office). We continue to pick up all the items we did in the past; there are now fees only for tires (\$5 each) and Mattresses (\$15 each), (box springs no charge), the cost that the Village pays for disposal. There is also a fee for multiple item bulk pick-up, such as 10 or more items or a whole house clean out.

Information about the Village Election is also noted in this newsletter. Please come to Village Hall to vote on March 19th. If you are unavailable to vote in person, you may apply to the Onondaga County Board of Elections for an Absentee Ballot. There will be candidates for Mayor, two(2) Trustee positions and Judge; there will also be a proposition to move the time of village elections from March to November. More information is available on the Village website.

As always, your Village Board members are available for all your questions and concerns. Please feel free to contact us at any time; we are here for you.

TALKING TRASH

- Automated collections Starts in May 2024
- Carts will be delivered to each property late spring
- 1 Trash cart/1 Recycle cart PER PROPERTY at no cost; this includes multi-family and businesses
- 2nd 96-gal cart may be purchased for trash or recycling;
- 2 PICKUP DAYS-- ONE FOR TRASH, ONE RECYCLING
- Old blue bins & trash cans will have a special collection date TBD
- Must call ahead to schedule pick up of bulky items that do not fit in trash cart, hard fill or building debris; Fee applies to mattresses or tires
- Same services, only better organized!

The pickup totes have been ordered and received by the village. Schedule is as follows:

- ⇒ Week of Feb 12 distribution of 13-gal tote containers to your house
- ⇒ Start March 1st First Pick up
- ⇒ Pick up 1st and 3rd Friday of month
- ⇒ Items that will be acceptable for program:
Vegetable, fruit scraps, coffee grounds, tea.
- ⇒ Items that will NOT be acceptable for program
Meat, fish, bones, dairy, eggs, bread, animal waste, grass clippings.

Housekeeping!!! You can use BPI certified compostable tote liners. Plastic and paper bags are not to be used.

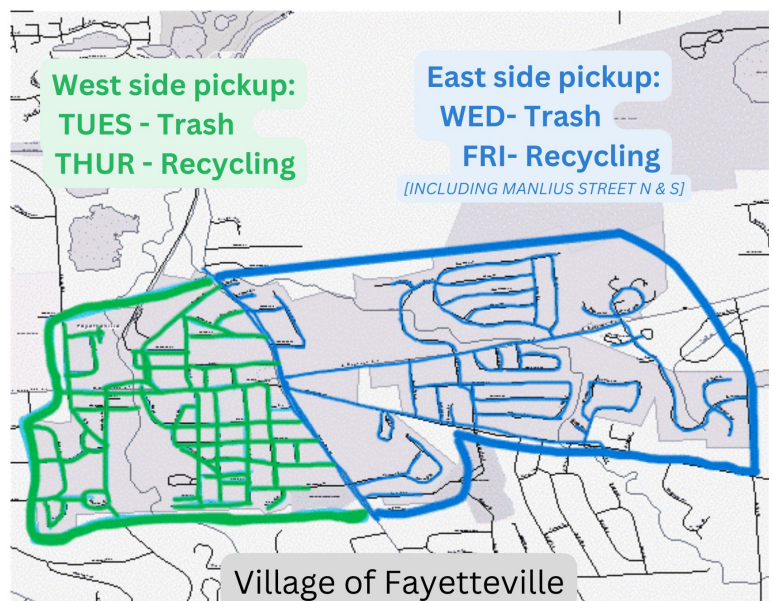
We are taking it slow to improve our systems and grow program. We will adjust systems and program to serve our residents and provide a valued program for our residents.
