2. Discussion: Vision, Goals, Strategies (continued from 4/7 meeting)

The Committee reviewed draft recommendations for the Vision, Goals, and Strategies.

Summary of comments:

- + Transportation
 - Prioritizing pedestrians over vehicles – shift in approach to planning for the Village
 - Level of Service as a driver of design for Genesee Street
 - Opportunities for traffic calming (make sure to include definitions in the plan)
- + Housing and Neighborhoods
 - Coordination with the Town, and closely look at the edge zoning for consistency across municipalities
 - Consider impacts on the school districts in the future
 - Include additional opportunities for the expansion of the Historic District
- + Community Resources
 - Acknowledge DPW in strategy 1
 - Combine strategies, where appropriate, to reduce redundancies (example - # 5 and 6 in the draft)
- + Climate Change, Adaptation, Sustainability
 - Add trees to help manage stormwater
 - Continue to educate the community on dark sky compliance
- + Local Economy
 - Role of technology and home-based businesses
