The spreadsheet (provided digitally) was used to record information about individual properties within the Village of Fayetteville boundary. It also forms the basis for the maps prepared by Onondaga County (Edward Hart) to support and illustrate the survey findings.

As work progressed, decisions were made about how to organize properties and which properties should be individually described in CRIS. The list uses three age horizons to accommodate the large number of properties located in subdivisions developed (although some were platted earlier) in the postwar period. Properties with main buildings constructed before 1945 are all described and photographed regardless of location—either in or out of recommended districts. The list includes historic locality or neighborhood for properties located in the historic core. Individual properties are generally evaluated for district eligibility ("x (district)" or "x (n/c)." These evaluations should be treated as recommendations for review in advance of preparing National Register nominations rather than final determinations should the village proceed with nominating districts.

Houses between 1945 and 1970 generally differ from later examples. Although many of the properties in this second category are now past their 50th anniversary, only some may be eligible for individual listing. The subdivisions were reviewed in the aggregate, and the information gathered is presented in Appendix 3. Most of these are marked "x" for non-contributing, but later review may alter that determination. but those located within the historic core and in prewar subdivisions are individually evaluated. The subdivisions or historic neighborhoods where parcels are located are noted as are previously listed resources.

Buildings constructed after 1970 are also generally reviewed in the aggregate if located in subdivisions. These are all considered non-contributing and marked "x." If located in a subdivision, this is noted in the entry.
